
SUMMER OF SERVICE PLANNING GUIDE

Our summer service guide is geared for kick-starting your volunteer planning with Global Volunteers. Dream. Have fun!



1. PLAN NOW.

We know that by now many of you will start solidifying your summer plans. We understand how quickly your calendars fill – and if you are trying to coordinate multiple family schedules with teen and student commitments to sports and band programs, camps, and internships – well,

then things just get trickier. The key is: start planning now!

Bonus: Volunteering is great for the soul! Researchers report that people of all ages who engage in service feel more satisfaction with their lives overall. This is worth planning for!

2. CONSULT YOUR PERSONAL VOLUNTEER COORDINATOR.

Did you know each volunteer is assigned an expert to



guide them through program registration? Your volunteer coordinator will advise you on open program dates, counsel you on discounts, and help you identify good

project matches, budget, schedule, and bucket list travel destinations.

Tip: Don't forget your friends and family members! Companion discounts can shave hundreds off your program contribution.



3. SECURE YOUR SPOT ON A PROGRAM.

We assemble teams throughout the year – your spot is secured with a \$350 deposit. Your volunteer coordinator will enter your registration as soon as you commit.

(1) Select your program and date. (2) Register online, by phone, or by mail.(3) Buy airfare when we notify you the team minimum has been met.

Early minimums allow us to assure our community host partners have a full complement of volunteers as they prepare for your arrival. Your team is forming now!

Remember: Your program contribution and airfare is 100% taxdeductible.


4. FUNDRAISE YOUR PROGRAM CONTRIBUTION.
